COWBOY CHAPTER #211 SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR MEMBERS AND THEIR CHILDREN/GRANDCHILDREN

Cowboy Chapter #211 offers annual scholarships to approved qualified applicants in support of their enrollment and attendance at an accredited college, university or certified trade school in pursuit of a bachelor degree, associate degree or trade certification.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBILITY

Individuals who may be awarded such scholarships include:

- A **MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING*** of Cowboy Chapter #211, or
- The son or daughter of a sponsoring member in good standing of Cowboy Chapter #211, or
- The son or daughter of a sponsoring member in good standing of Daughters of Penelope, Olympus Chapter #6, if the son or daughter does not have a father who is eligible, available and/or capable of becoming a member of the Cowboy Chapter #211 , or
- The grandson or granddaughter of a sponsoring member in good standing of Cowboy Chapter #211 for a one year scholarship only, unless the grandson or granddaughter does not have a father who is eligible, available and/or capable of becoming a member of the Chapter, in which case applications may be made for up to four years of scholarships, and
- The applicant must have a cumulative high school or college grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.0 in order to qualify for up to a \$1200 annual award. Applicants who have or later attain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher will be eligible for up to a \$1600 annual scholarship.

*As noticed in the 2021 scholarship requirements, the 2022 scholarships require sponsoring members to be a “member in good standing” and will be required to have attended a minimum of three (3) meetings and participated as an active committee member during each of the two (2) years prior to the date of the application.

PROCEDURE

- Applicants must complete and submit the “AHEPA MEMBER-SPONSORED SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION” form along with all required documents as outlined therein by NO LATER THAN JUNE 15th of the year in which studies will begin. Applications are available online by clicking this link: [AHEPA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS](#) Paper copies will only be distributed to those who have a legitimate excuse.
- Sponsors must fill out the attached sponsor form (**Scholarship Sponsor Form (version 2022)**) and send a copy to the scholarship chair, Nick Bellack, at nickbellack@gmail.com

AHEPA's mission is to promote the ancient Hellenic ideals of education, philanthropy, civic responsibility, integrity, and family and individual excellence through community service and volunteerism.

- All applications will be reviewed by the five members, including the Chairman, of the Scholarship Committee, who will make the final determination whether or not eligibility requirements have been met in each case
- On or about September 1 of each year for no more than four years, successful applicants will be awarded an amount, depending on available funds, which will be prorated among all recipients.
- Scholarship checks will be sent to the Registrar of the chosen educational institution, to be held until picked up by the recipient at the time of registration.
- After the initial application and award, scholarship recipients will be required to complete and send an application to the Chapter before June 15th of each successive year, for up to three additional years, informing of their intent to continue their education, advising of any changes in educational institution to be attended and providing a copy of their academic transcript demonstrating that the required GPA has been maintained for the previous year.
